## **COVID-19 Rules:**

All participants and shinpan must be well versed in the special COVID-19 rules as required by the CKF. A brief overview of the rules in place will be taking place during the opening ceremony.

We ask that all participants and attendees do a COVID self-check before attending the events. If you are instructed to isolate, we ask that you not attend any of the events.

**Masks will be required** for everyone including the following:

- Non-bogu players
- \*Bogu players
- Shinpan
- Volunteers
- Spectators

\*Bogu players will not be required to wear masks if they are wearing a men equipped with a lower or full face shield.

### **Tournament Divisions\*\*:**

- A - Individual Non-Bogu (18 yrs. old & under)
- B - Individual Bogu (10 yrs. old & under)
- C - Individual Bogu (11 - 13 yrs. old)
- D - Individual Bogu (14 - 15 yrs. old)
- E - Individual Bogu (16 - 18 yrs. old)

#### **Team (Bogu):**

- 10 - 13 yrs. old
- 14 - 18 yrs. old

3 players per team; spare players may join other club's teams as needed.

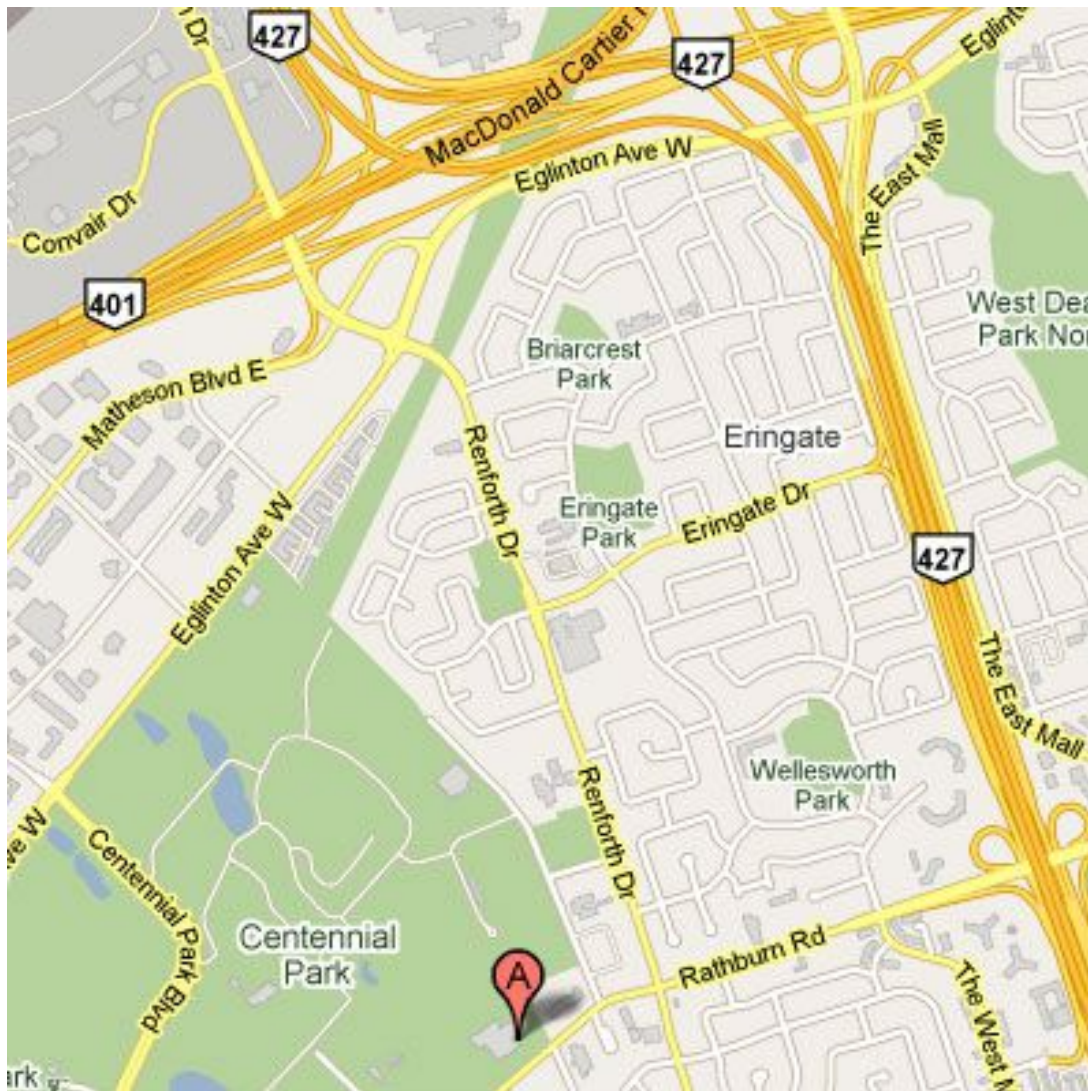
*\*\* Divisions are subject to change (may combine or split) depending on the number of participants for each division*

### **Registration:**

- ***Deadline is Sunday, October 9, 2022***

- All registration forms must be submitted by the deadline date.
- All waivers and payments must be received by the registration time.
- All competitors must be or have been 18 years of age or under as of January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022. The age of each bogu competitor on January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022 is to be used to determine the division the respective competitor is to participate in.
- All competitors must wear keikogi and hakama to participate in the tournament.
- All bogu competitors must also wear zekken.
- Each competitor must provide a signed waiver to participate in the tournament (attached).
- Each club is asked to complete and send a single registration form on behalf of its club members.
- Registering clubs are asked to complete the “Shinpan List” (second tab of the Registration Excel file).

- Take Renforth Dr. exit and head South.
